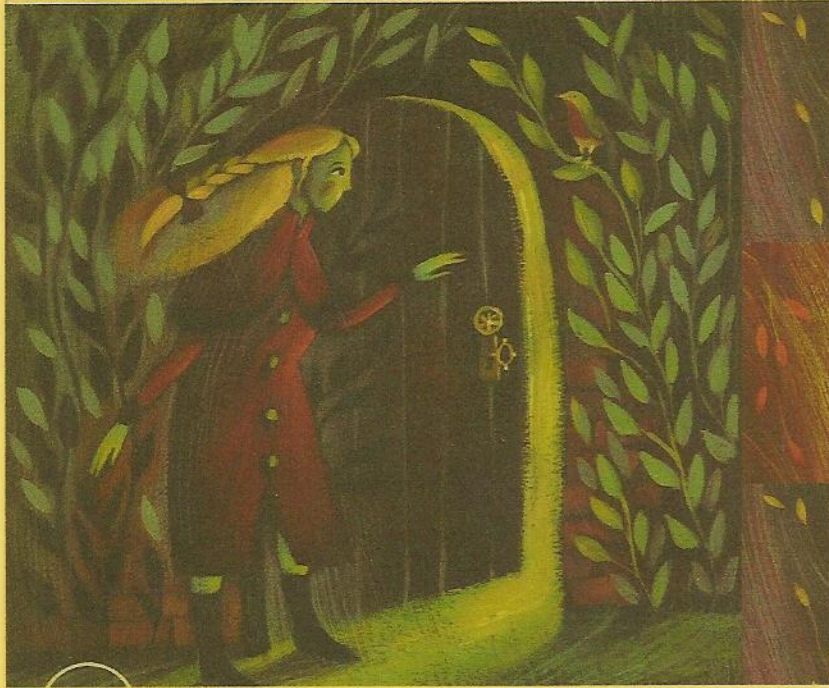


Στο τέλος οι μαθητές ετοίμασαν μία εργασία και είδαν την ταινία του βιβλίου.

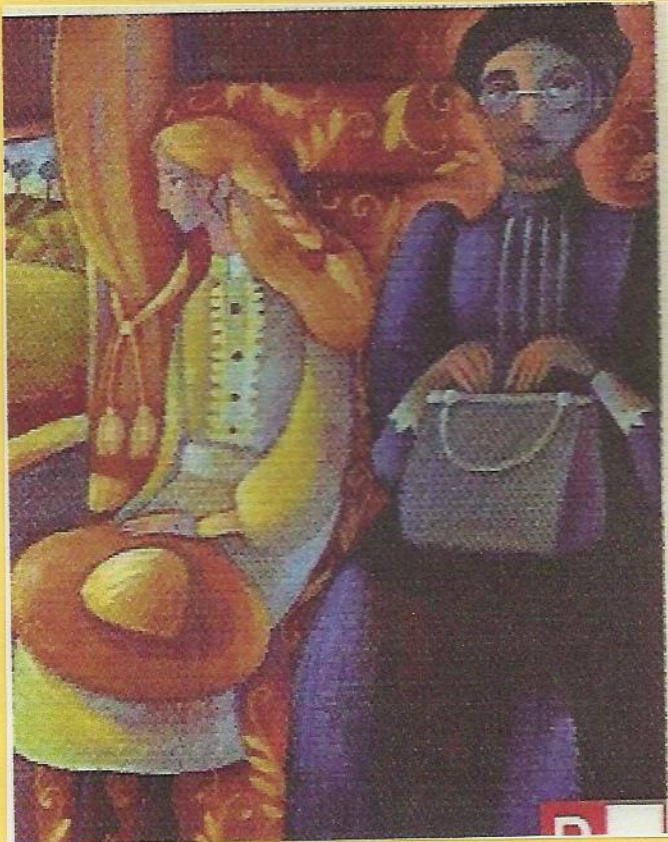

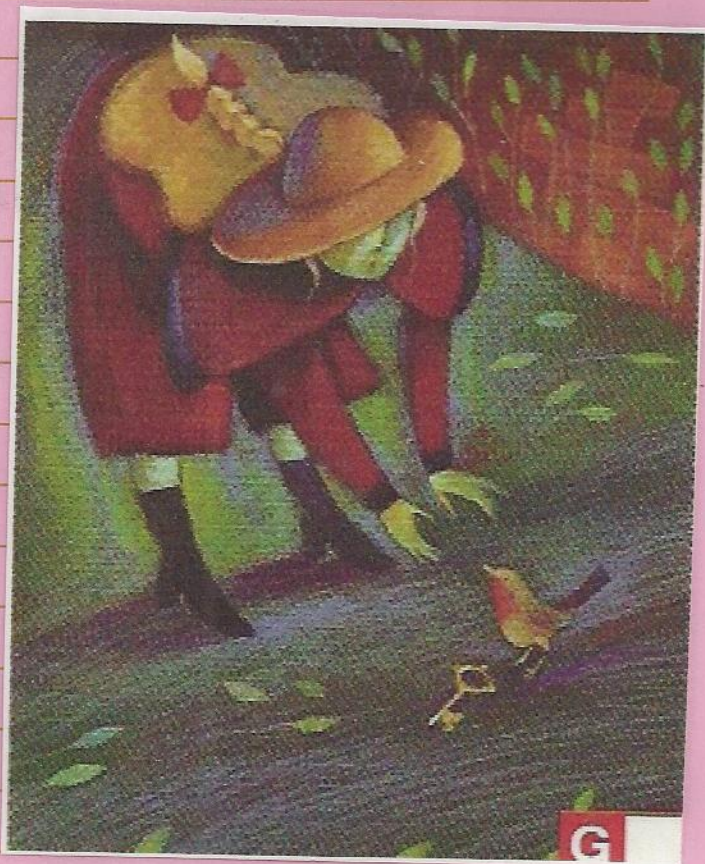


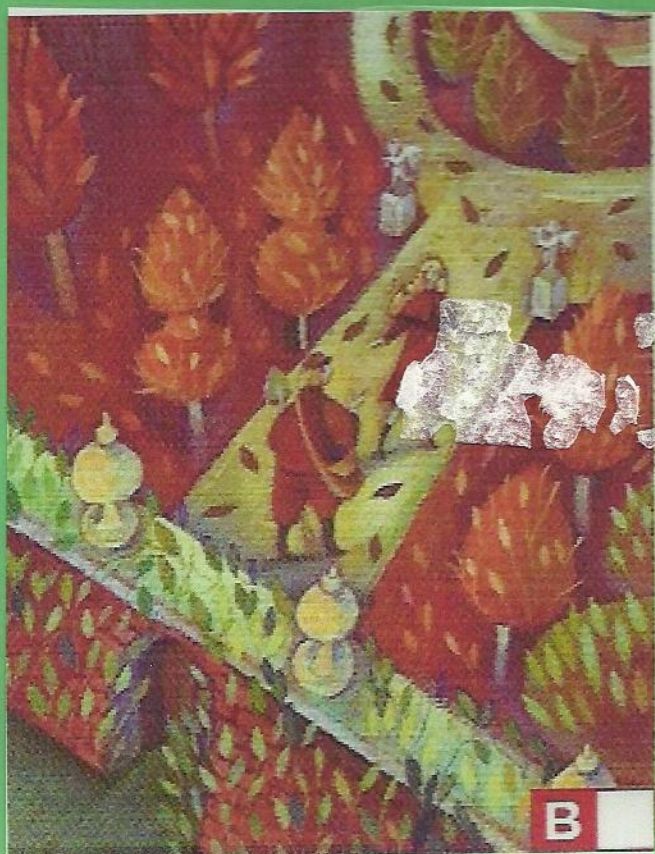
Mary meets Ben Weatherstaff he is Mr. Cravens gardener. Mary asks him about one of the gardens and Ben gets angry.

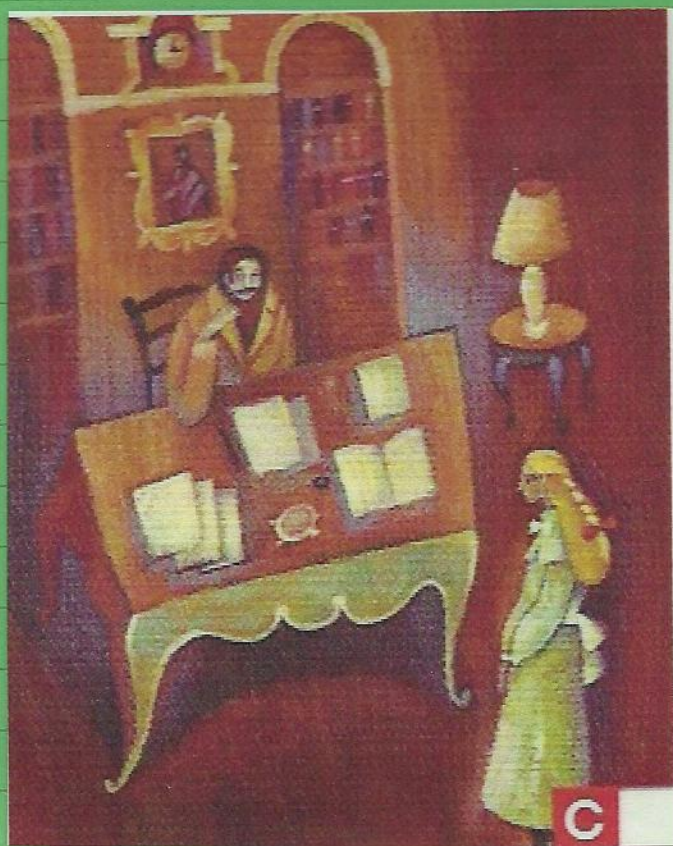


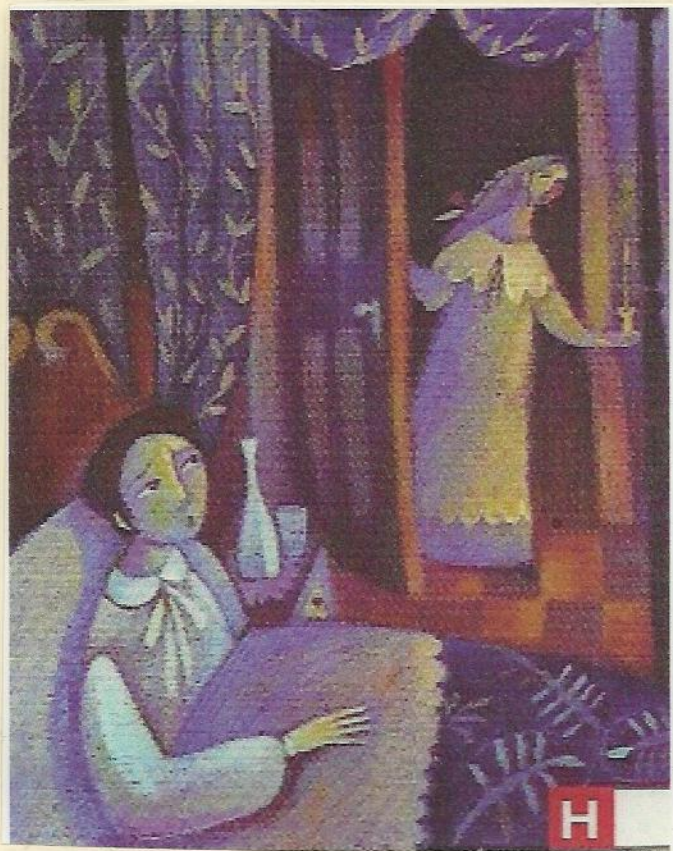
Mary and Dickon go into the secret garden and see all the dead trees and they decide to save them and make it beautiful again.

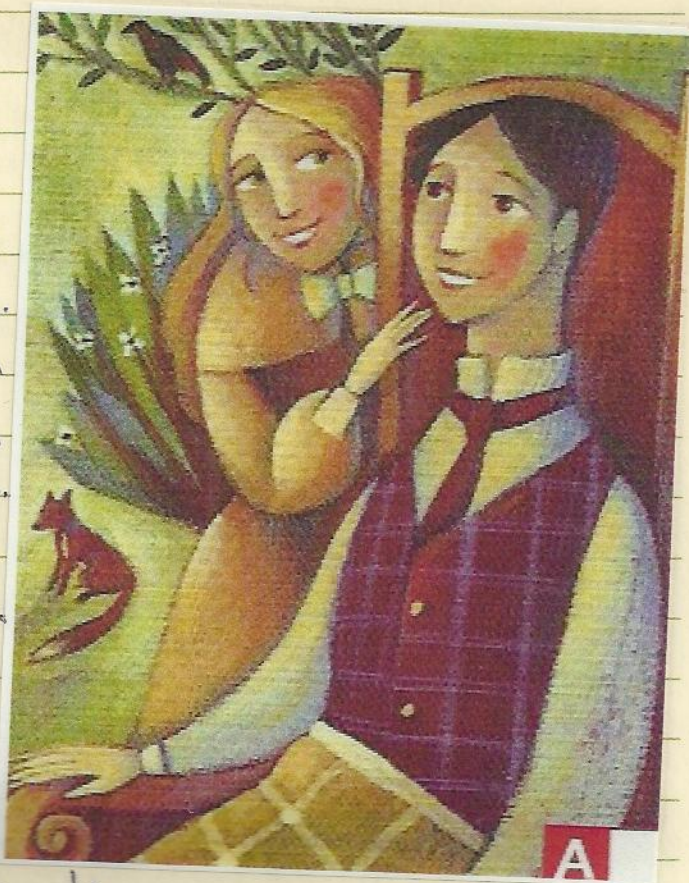




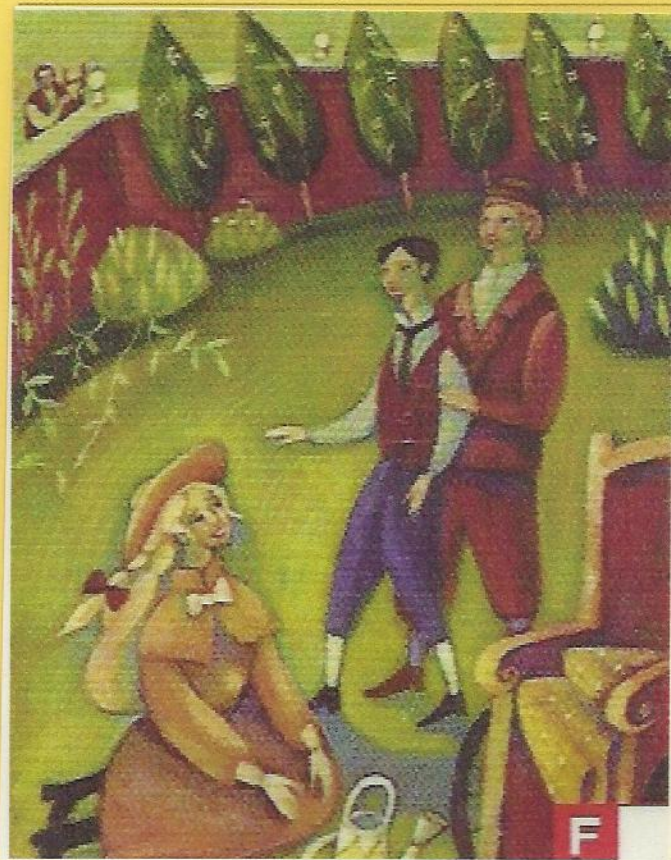
